

## **DISRUPTION ON KONKAN RAILWAY ROUTE DUE TO UNPRECEDENTED RAINFALL**

Due to continuous unprecedented rainfall on the Konkan Railway Route and resultant Settlement of Embankment at Nivsar Station as well as poor visibility in the section, Konkan Railway has been compelled to cancel the following trains as a Precautionary Safety Measure for its esteemed passengers :-
