TENDER NOTICE

1. On behalf of Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd., Sr. Regional Electrical Engineer, Karwar invites Bids for the following work from experienced contractors having E.P.F. registration numbers allotted by EPF Commissioner:

Name of the work	Annual Maintenance of pumping installations and electrical motors under Karwar region (Pernem to Thokur section & KRIST, Manglore).
Contract Period	Two years from the date of issue of Letter of Acceptance

2. Brief scope of work includes periodical maintenance of following 101 Nos. of pump sets and 29 Nos. of electrical motors assorted capacities as per schedules and as per accepted engineering practices:

- (i) Open well submersible / Borewell pumps : 50 Nos.
- (ii) Centrifugal pumps : 51 Nos.
- (iii) Siren 2 KM range (0.5HP, 1ph motors) : 12 Nos.
- (iv) Siren 8 KM range (3HP, 3ph motors) : 05 Nos.
- (v) 3HP, 3ph motors : 12 Nos.

These pump sets are located at various sites from Pernem to Thokur section & KRIST, Manglore under Karwar region of Konkan Railway. These details are furnished in the tender document.

3. Only those firms which satisfy all of the following eligibility criteria need quote for this tender;

- (a) Should have been a Manufacturer or Supplier or OEM /OEA or regular contractor / agency in the field of maintenance of pump sets and electrical motors.



- (b) Should have completed in the three financial years and current financial year, at least one **similar nature of single work** for a minimum value of **Rs.5.03 lakhs**. **Works of similar nature** means Annual Maintenance Contract for pump sets and electrical motors, supply and erection of pumps / electrical motors awarded by any of the following:
- (i) Central Government,
 - (ii) Public Sector Units,
 - (iii) State Governments,
- (c) Should have received a minimum of **Rs.21.56 lakhs** as the contract payment during the last three financial years and in the current financial year.
- (d) Have financial stability and status to meet the financial obligations pursuant to the work covered in the Bid Documents. Bidders are required to submit a **“SOLVENCY CERTIFICATE”** of value not less than **Rs.5.00 lakhs**, issued by any **Nationalised Bank**. Any other certificate like “Credit Limit / Capability” etc. are not acceptable.
- (e) Have field service organization available to provide the necessary field management services required to successfully and expeditiously maintain the equipment (Pump sets electrical motors) properly and within the time period specified. The evidence shall cover the details of management and technical personnel available and proposed to be made available
- (f) Do not engage in any illegal activities and is not debarred by any Govt. Dept./ Agency/ Organization / Establishment from transaction with them.
4. Following document shall be required to be submitted by firm to judge working capability and capacity of the firms:
- i) Firm’s structure and organization.
 - ii) List of works completed by the firm in last 5 years.
 - iii) List of ongoing works awarded to the contract but not completed.
 - iv) Annual Turnover data of the firm (from all sources)
 - v) Last Audit Report from registered Chartered Accountant.
 - vi) Solvency Certificate issued by any Nationalised Bank.
 - vii) Litigation History
5. Non transferable Bid documents containing Instructions to bidders, Special conditions of contract, Scope of Work, Schedules of Quantities & Rates etc. that form part of the Bid documents can be obtained by the interested Bidder who fulfill the qualifying requirements as brought out above on submission of a formal request and payment of **Rs.1125/-** (Rupees Eleven Thousand One Hundred Twenty Five only) inclusive of Sales Tax, towards Cost of the Bid document by Non-refundable crossed Demand Draft of any Nationalised Bank

drawn in favour of Sr.Regional Accounts Officer, Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd. payable at Karwar The Bid documents can be obtained from the office of the Regional Railway Manager, Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd., Shirwad, Karwar on any working day from 04.03.2010 **between 10 AM to 5 PM.**

- 5.1 Tender documents can be down loaded and printed from KRCL's Website www.konkanrailway.com and submitted along with DD for payment towards tender document cost. Tender documents received without DD for payment towards tender document cost shall be summarily rejected.
6. **Earnest Money Deposit:** Bidder is required to deposit **Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** in the form of a crossed Demand Draft / Pay Order of any Nationalised Bank drawn in favour of Sr.RAO,Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd. payable at Karwar.
7. Bid documents shall not be sent by Post. Bid documents shall not be issued **after 12.00 hrs** on the date of opening.
8. Tenders not accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit, tender document down loaded from website not accompanied by cost of tender document and incomplete offers shall be summarily rejected.
9. The offer shall be kept open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of the opening of the tender.
10. The offer complete in all respects and sealed with lac in an envelope will be received up to **15.00 Hrs. on 05.04.2010** in the office of Regional Railway Manager, Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd., Shirwad, Karwar Bids will be opened on the same day at 15.30 hrs in the presence of the tenderers or their representative who may choose to attend. In case this day becomes a holiday, the offers will be received up to and opened at the same specified time on next working day. Offers received after specified due date and time will not be entertained.
11. Notwithstanding anything stated above, KRCL reserves the right to assess applicants' capability and capacity to perform the works, should the circumstances warrant such an assessment in the overall interest of KRCL.
12. KRCL reserves the right to cancel / withdraw the invitation for applications without assigning any reason and shall bear no liability whatsoever consequent upon such a decision.
