

KRCL CSR ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN IN F.Y. 2022-23

Unspent amount of Rs.10,23,409/- of FY2021-22 was utilized for the following CSR activities during FY 2022-23 in Education and Sports Sector.

1. IMPARTING SOFTSKILLS TRAINING:

 KRCL has constructed and developed RHSDC with an aim to promote Skill Development for sustainable income generation & livelihood. During the year total 4939 students have (3469 female students) been trained in Soft Skills, which was combination of Online and Offline mode. The various topics covered were Office etiquettes, CV Writing, Public Speaking, Time Management, Start-up & Entrepreneurship, Time Management, etc. (Rs. 49,237/-)





2. COMPUTER LITERACY PROGRAM:

Basic Computer Literacy programme under activities relating to promotion of education, were revived during the year in rural areas for school children on Konkan Railway route where Computer facilities and trained teachers are not available. The activity is in line with the mission of Digital India and inculcating computer awareness for the GenNext. During FY 2022-23 in 09 Schools of Ratnagiri and Karwar Region computer literacy programs were conducted wherein 1659 students (767 female students) were trained. (Rs. 1,14,786/-)













3. PROVISION OF FOOTBALL KIT TO SCHOOLS: (ITEM NO. VII OF SCHEDULE VII OF COMPANIES ACT, 2013)

 To promote nationalized sports, football kits were provided to Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalay schools in the districts of Sindhudurg and Raigad, which will help not only in physical development of the school children but also in communication, teamwork and building confidence. 4. CSR FUND FOR COVID-19:

 Providing of one AC Bolero vehicle for surveillance of public health activities including COVID-19 in Udupi District, Karnataka. This CSR activity was carried out in the financial year 2021-22 but the payment of Rs.8,24,386/- was made in the year 2022-23.
